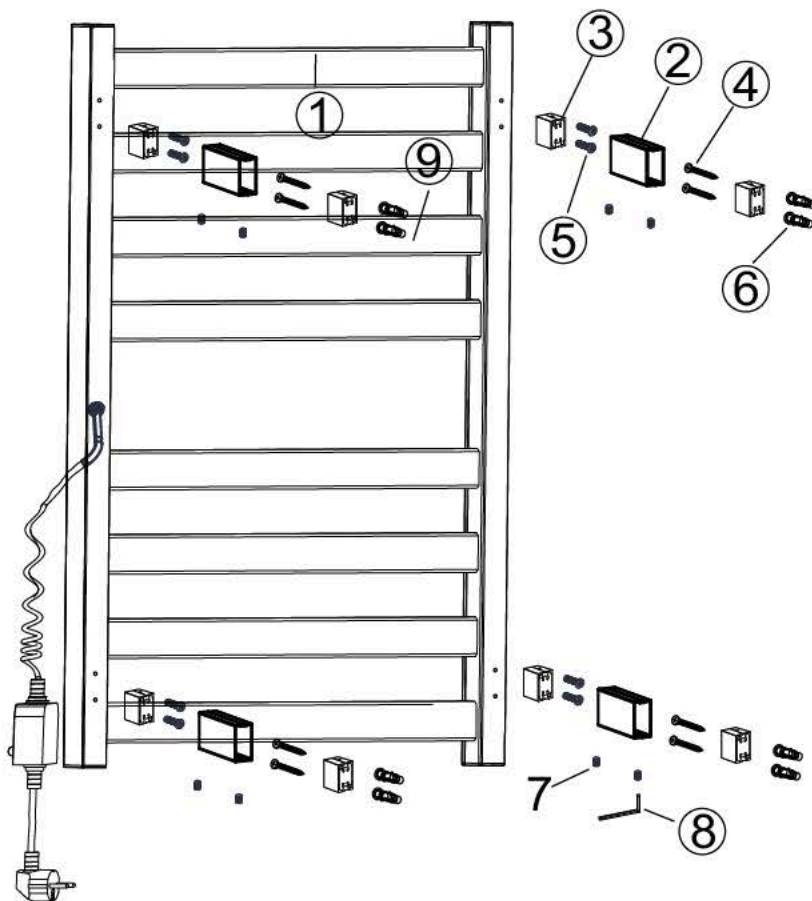
 Caution: Possible risk of injury to person or damage of product. To ensure the safety of installation, please equip yourself with protection equipment.

Operation guide for socket and temperature controlled switch

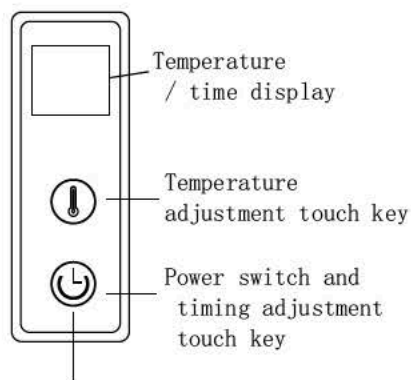
After leakage protection power off, press this button to return to normal

Leakage reset key

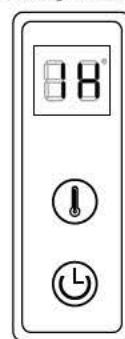
Press test key to test whether to protect the power off. Press this key and then press the reset key to restore normal power supply

Without electricity



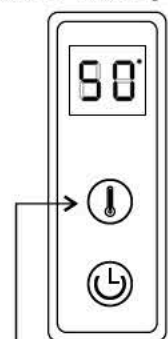
It glows when power on, keep pressing about 5 seconds, the display screen has a digital display (as shown in the right picture) the towel rail starts to work

In the electricity (Timing setting)



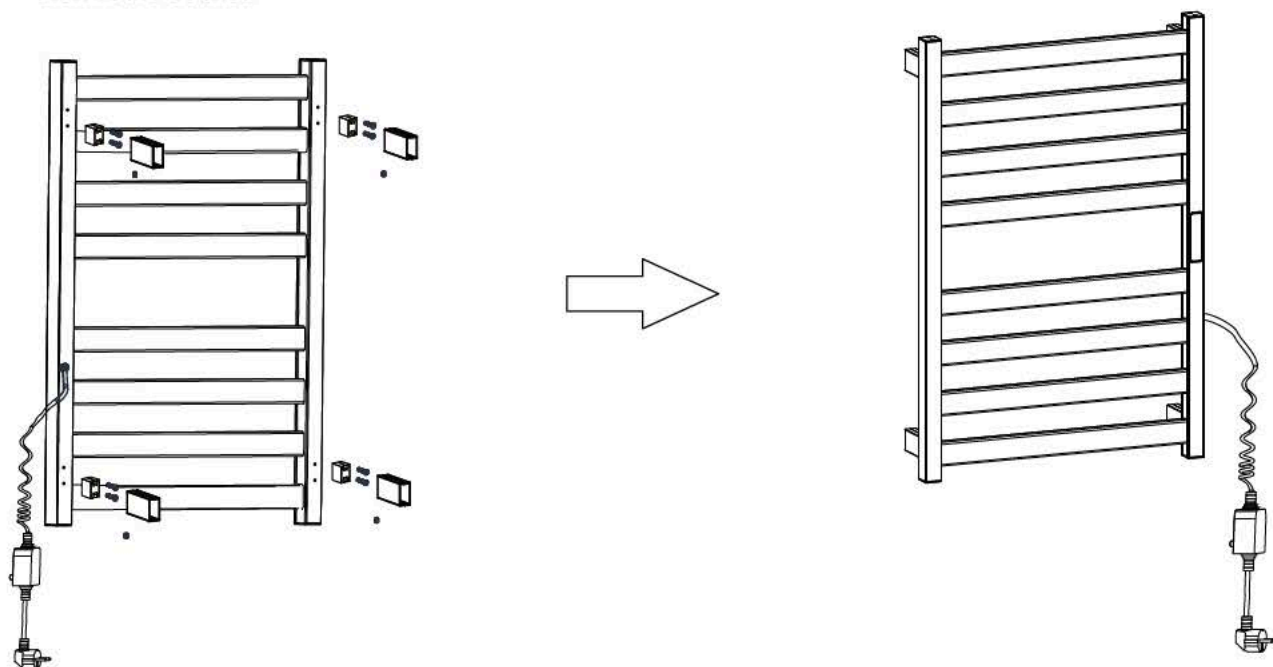
Click here to set the timing time (there are 1-8 hours optional), the key stops flashing, and the setting is completed

In the electricity (Temperature setting)

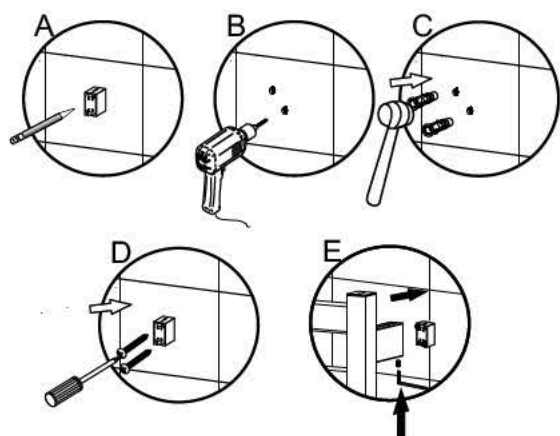
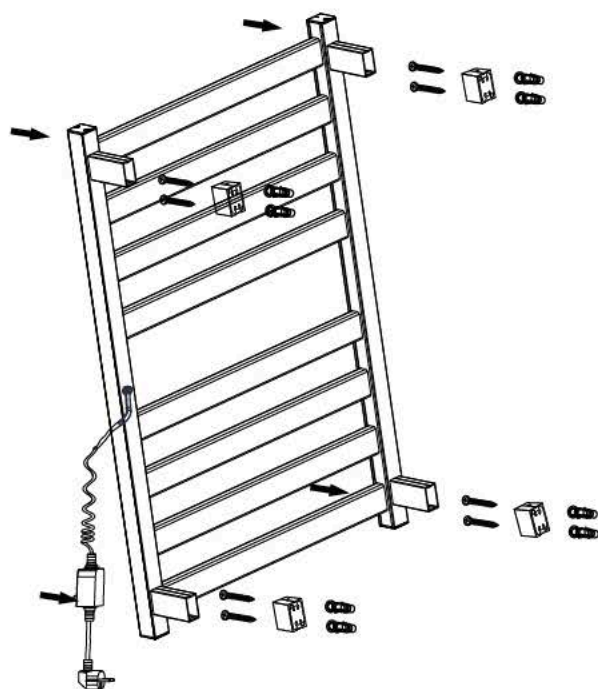


Click here to set the temperature (there are 45, 50, 55, 60, 65, 70 degrees optional), the key stops flashing, and the setting is completed

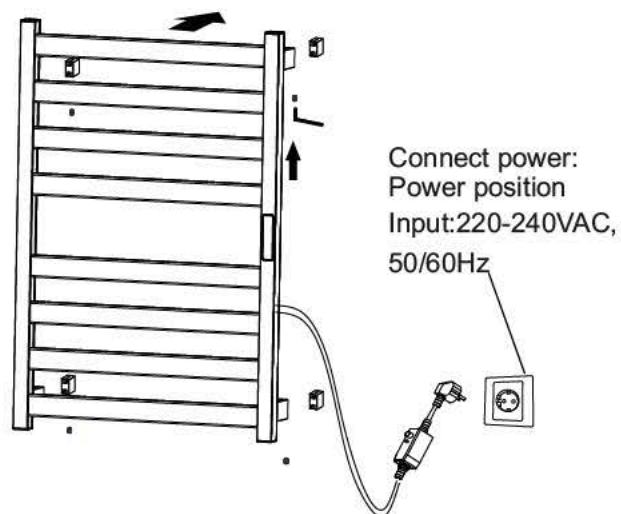
1. Install the wall connector behind the Towel bar, then fit the socket.



2. Install the wall connector to the wall according to the below sheet, then position the Towel Bar over the wall connector.



3. Use the Allen key to tighten the screw and fasten the Towel bar to the wall.
